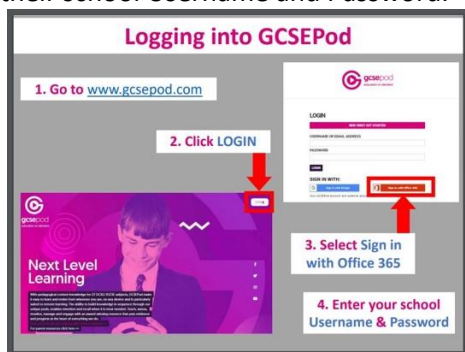


GCSEPod Update 1st May 2020
