Stronger Starts Retail Apprenticeship Programme

Join the webinar on Tuesday 14th May (4pm-5pm or 6pm-7pm). If you are not able to make either of these times, still register so you can receive the recording. This scheme is one of the few apprenticeship programmes that doesn't require any qualifications or experience as entry requirements.

After completing the programme, apprentices gain a Level 2 National Standard in Retail, which is the equivalent of 5 GCSE passes.

The apprenticeship is delivered by Tesco's partner, Lifetime Training, and will take a minimum of 12 months to complete. Follow this link for more information
