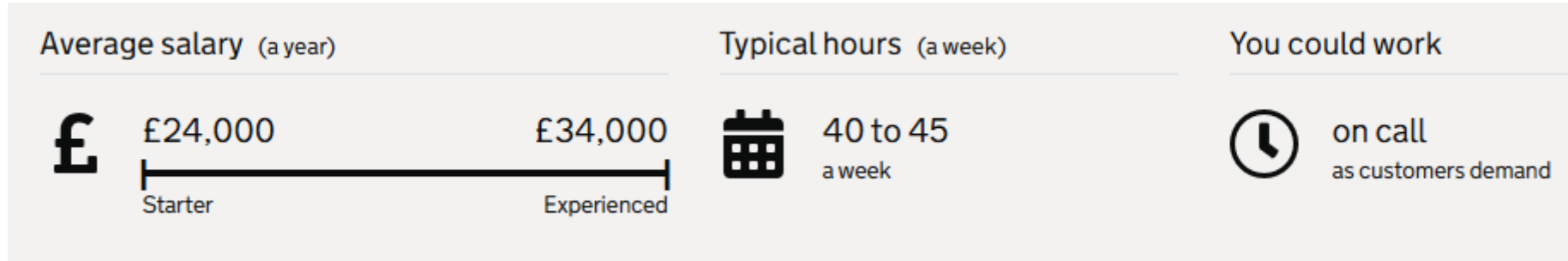


Windscreen Fitter

Windscreen fitters repair and replace damaged glass on cars, vans, buses and lorries.



Skills and knowledge

- the ability to work well with your hands
- the ability to use, repair and maintain machines and tools
- the ability to organise your time and workload
- customer service skills
- to be thorough and pay attention to detail
- the ability to use your initiative
- patience and the ability to remain calm in stressful situations
- the ability to work well with others
- to be able to carry out basic tasks on a computer or hand

Different routes to get this job

(check the website for entry requirements)

- a college course
- an apprenticeship
- applying directly
- drive to meet the customer or welcome them to the workshop
- assess the damage to glass and advise the customer on repair options
- repair small chips in glass with resin
- disconnect electrical wiring, like window controls
- remove trims from around windows
- remove and replace damaged glass, and reconnect electrics
- record work details for each job
- process payments
