I wanted to share an update on the recent trip to Oxford University's Mathematical Institute with our Year 9 girls. It was an incredibly inspiring experience that provided valuable insight into university life and the world of Maths beyond the classroom.

The students engaged in a range of hands-on activities, including:

- Using real satellite data and exploring how we can use Maths to make connections and observation about climate change.
- Working on knot theory (still an active field of research) and how you mathematically define a knot
- Participating in a Q&A session with current undergraduate students
- Exploring higher dimensions

The trip not only broadened their understanding of mathematical applications but also motivated them to consider future opportunities in higher education.

You were brilliant ambassadors for Thamesmead.

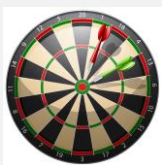
