<p>Course Description</p> <p>The Tech Award gives learners the opportunity to develop sector-specific applied knowledge and skills through realistic vocational contexts.</p> <p>Component 1: Learners will explore the different types and provision of sport and physical activity available for different types of participants, barriers to participation and ways to overcome these barriers to increase participation in sport and physical activity. They will also research equipment and technological advances in a chosen sport or physical activity and how to prepare our bodies for participation in sport and physical activity.</p> <p>Component 2: Learners will investigate the components of fitness and their effect on performance, take part in practical sport, explore the role of officials in sport and learn to apply methods and sporting drills to improve other participants' sporting performance.</p> <p>Component 3: Learners will be introduced to and develop an understanding of the importance of fitness and the different types of fitness for performance in sport and physical activity. They will also develop an understanding of the body and fitness testing.</p> <p>Students would learn about the theory side of PE and then have a variety of written assessments (under exam conditions) and a written test.</p>	<p>Entry Requirements</p> <p>Entry requirements: Pupils should have an interest in sport, physical activity and exercise. Pupils should be participating in at least one extra-club afterschool. Pupils will need to complete a workbook prior to starting the course</p>
<p>Assessment</p> <p>The assessment for the Pearson BTEC Level 1/Level 2 Tech Award in Sport are as follows:</p> <p>2 Internal Written Assignments set by exam board (60% of Final Mark) Both are internally and externally marked and moderated.</p> <p>Component 1: Preparing Participants to Take Part in Sport and Physical Activity (5 hours of supervised assessment)</p> <p>Component 2: Taking Part and Improving Other Participants Sporting Performance (4 hours of supervised assessment)</p> <p>External Synoptic Assessment (40% of Final Mark) Component 3: A written assessment that requires learners to demonstrate that they can identify and use effectively an appropriate selection of skills, techniques, concepts, theories and knowledge from across the whole qualification in an integrated way.
